

Returning to the UK from a country with quarantine restrictions

If you are returning to the UK, including a transit stop, from a country that is not included in the 'travel corridor' you will be required to self-isolate (quarantine) for 14 days upon your return.

Additional countries with restrictions (as at 17 th August 2020)	Subject to 14 days quarantine
Austria, Croatia, Trinidad and Tobago	If you arrive in the UK after 4.00am on 22 nd August 2020
Aruba, France, Malta, Monaco, the Netherlands or Turks and Caicos Islands	If you arrive in the UK after 4.00am on 15 th August 2020
Andorra, The Bahamas or Belgium	If you arrive in the UK after 4.00am on 8 th August 2020
Spain, Balearic Islands (Majorca, Menorca, Ibiza and Formentera) or Canary Islands (Tenerife, Fuerteventura, Gran Canaria, Lanzarote, La Palma, La Gomera, El Hierro and La Graciosa)	If you arrive in the UK after 4.00am on 26 th July 2020

This means, if you have returned from a country subject to quarantine, your daughter will not be able to return to school until after the 14 day quarantine period has ended:

Before midnight on the 1 st September 2020	16 th September 2020

From the start of the Autumn Term 2020, pupil attendance will be mandatory, however the Secretary of State has advised that no parent will be penalised for following the official public health advice for their child. Pupils who are required to quarantine will be given a new category of non-attendance (code X) which will not count as an absence for statistical purposes.
