General Overview

The Psychology Department at BHCHS is a successful department. It currently consists of 1 graduate specialist teacher who can teach the full range of the Psychology curriculum. Psychology is one of the most popular and successful subjects in the sixth form and we are looking to expand into the delivery of level 3 Btec Psychology.

Based in a dedicated sixth form building, the teaching of Years 12 and 13 takes place in a specialist teaching room. All classrooms boast interactive whiteboards that are supported by computers and internet access.

In Psychology we follow the AQA A-Level course with three exams at the end of year 13. Students have the opportunity to attend a range of visits and conferences as part of the course offer.

Planning and delivery is semester based, and the department has a good range of resources to support the delivery of the curriculum. Colleagues across the school are encouraged to share good practice with others, and to develop their own practice, ensuring challenge and engagement are at its core.
