Please visit <https://www.edulinkone.com> to book appointments via the portal or you can book directly via the Edulink app on your smart phone. A link to the portal is shown on our website. This is an online appointment booking system which allows you to choose your own appointment time with each of your daughter's teachers. Appointments are for 5 minutes and will time out at the end of each appointment, you will then be connected to the next appointment automatically.

Included with this email is an instructions booklet explaining video messaging via Edulink, this is to help parents navigate this new system. You should already have access to your own parental section of the Edulink app, usernames and passwords were allocated in September. If you are having any issues logging on please email chantlerd@broughtonhall.com and we will reset your account.
