Short Inspection of Broughton Hall Catholic High School

On Wednesday 23rd January our school was inspected under the Short Inspection Framework, this is a one day Ofsted Inspection.

The Inspection Report has now been officially published and so is available to view on our website and as a paper copy on request.

There is no change to the schools current overall effectiveness grade of good as a result of this inspection.

This is very welcome news but I consider it important that you have a clear picture of the outcome of this inspection. There are many positives in our report including the recognition of how we have been working to bring about improvements in particular areas. Teaching is improving and many pupils are beginning to make better progress, in particular disadvantaged pupils.

It is testament to you as parents and carers as well as to our staff that pupils were described as being respectful young people who follow instructions promptly and who enjoy their learning. We are delighted to hear you feel your children are happy at school and feel safe. Thank you for reassuring Inspectors that any concerns you have are dealt with promptly. Safeguarding was judged as effective and pupils were reported as knowing how to keep themselves safe and they trust their teachers. Inspectors considered our school records and they spoke to pupils and concluded bullying was rare and dealt with effectively when it did occur.

The skills and experience of our Governors was acknowledged, as was the pride they felt at being a Governor of our school.

All the above were good to hear but we must act on the areas we need to improve upon. In the report reference is made to a decline in standards, this reflects the outcomes in some subject areas but you will also note Inspectors recognised we have been working to bring about the necessary improvements.

Inspectors have identified many areas of good practice and we have been given four points for next steps which we will utilise to secure good teaching and learning and to improve outcomes for all our pupils.
