KS3: Year 8 Cultures (2 Rotations)



Areas of Recap:

- Using the formal elements to develop drawings skills.
- Independent research skills
- Presentation and annotation

Skill development : Effective Presentation

Through continued focus on sketchbook presentation students will build on their skills through developing creative and effective pages.

Skill development : Independent Research

Students will have the opportunity to expand their research skills when investigating these cultures both in lesson and for homework.

Skill development : a range of techniques

Students will have the opportunity to try out a range of techniques including sgraffito, poly printing, 3D work with clay and painting with watercolour and inks.

Skill development: Observational Drawing

Students will develop their drawing skills, focusing on drawing from a secondary source. There will be 1 Formative Drawing Assessment per rotation.

Mexican Art

Students will learn about the Day of the Dead and its significance in Mexican culture through art. They will explore traditional symbols like sugar skulls and **marigolds**, and create colourful artworks inspired by the vibrant decorations and themes of this special celebration.

Aboriginal Art

Students will learn about Aboriginal art and its deep connection to Indigenous Australian culture and storytelling. They will create their own artworks that reflect the stories and landscapes important to Aboriginal people

Indian Art

Students will explore Indian art, learning about its rich history and diverse styles, including traditional patterns, vibrant colours, and intricate designs. They will study elements like mandalas and henna art, creating their own pieces inspired by Indian cultural symbols and artistic techniques

Japanese Art

Students will discover Japanese art, exploring traditional styles such as ukiyo-e woodblock prints, calligraphy, and ink painting. They will learn about the importance of nature and simplicity in Japanese aesthetics and create their own artwork inspired by these techniques and themes
