Skill development : Effective Presentation

Through continued focus on sketchbook presentation students will build on their skills through developing creative and effective pages.

Skill development : Independent Research

Students will have the opportunity to expand their research skills when investigating Indian art and culture both in lesson and for homework.

Skill development : Printing techniques

We will experiment with a range of printing and image transfer techniques such as oil pastel and graphite printing.

Skill development: Observational Drawing

Students will develop their apply their drawing skills in an assessed drawing piece of an Indian Elephant using the grid technique to draw from a secondary source.

An introduction to India

Students will discuss what they already know about India and will develop further understanding of the countries population, regions, religions and traditions.

Investigating Indian Art and Culture
