Dear Parent/Carer.

RE: GL Assessments - English, Mathematics and Science progress tests and CAT4

As part of our assessment programme, after May half term, year 7, 8 and 9 students will sit a series of short progress tests in English, Mathematics and Science along with CAT4 testing. Each test is standardised against national benchmarks using the GL Assessment platform. The purpose of the tests is to provide each year team with information to support students' progress in preparation for the new academic year 2023/24, which includes:

- Future curriculum planning and sequencing
- Adjustments to teaching, learning and assessments
- ➤ KS4 target setting
- To help identify any additional support individual students may need

The Progress Test in Science measures students' knowledge and understanding of science, as well as their application of this knowledge and understanding. Their ability to work scientifically is also assessed. The Progress Test in English measures students' knowledge, understanding and application of technical English skills (spelling, grammar and punctuation) and reading comprehension, using age-appropriate fiction and information texts. The Progress Test in Maths measures students' mathematical skills and knowledge in areas such as number, shape, data handling and algebra, as well as their mathematical reasoning and problem-solving skills.

The Cognitive Abilities Test (CAT4) assesses a student's ability to think across four different reasoning batteries:

Verbal reasoning – thinking with words Quantitative reasoning – thinking with number Non-Verbal reasoning – thinking with shapes Spatial reasoning – thinking with shapes and space

Importantly, CAT4 also provides indicators for national tests and examinations, which will be particularly useful in measuring and monitoring student achievement during their time at Broughton Hall.
