Pupils in Year 11 who began their Silver Award last year need to check their school e-mails and log onto their e-dofe accounts. Those who completed both expeditions should have sent Mr Kennaugh their Qualifying Expedition presentation and will have received their assessor report via their e-dofe account.

One they have finished the 3, 6 or 12 months of their chosen activity, they must upload a fully completed and correct assessor report to their e-dofe account.
