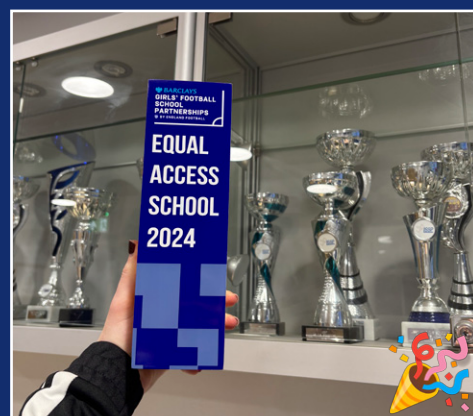


Weekly Prayer

I'll be coming into assemblies next week to promote the new Bronze and Silver Awards with Years 9 and 10.

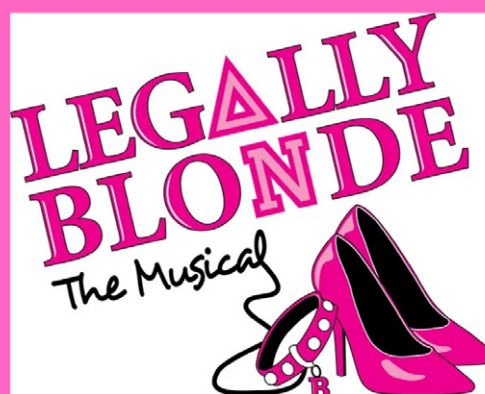
