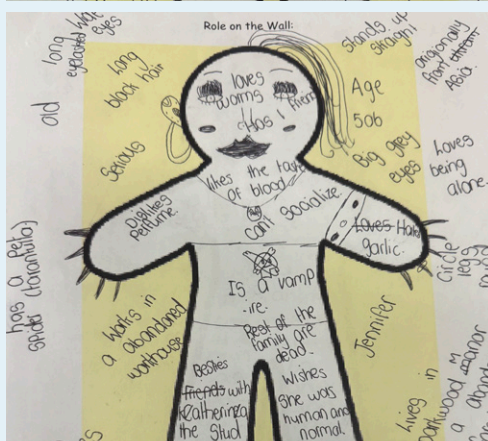
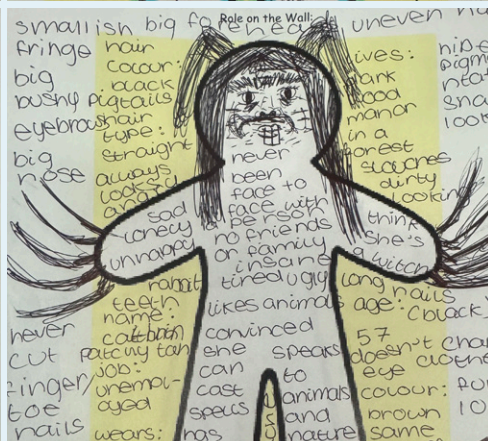
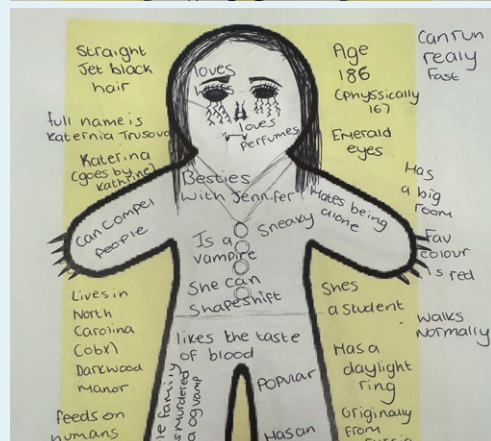
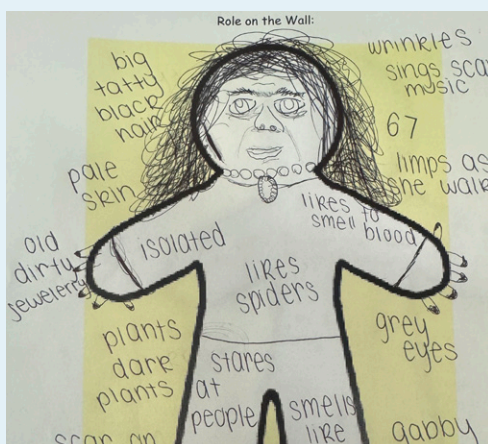
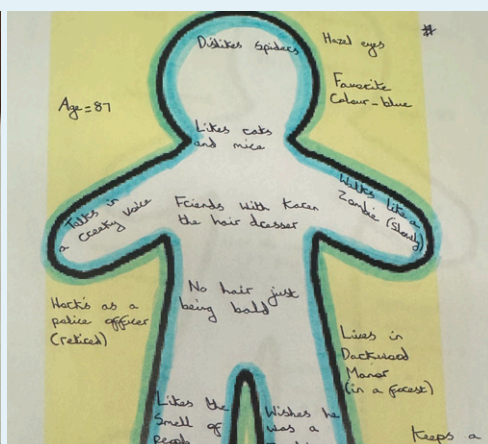
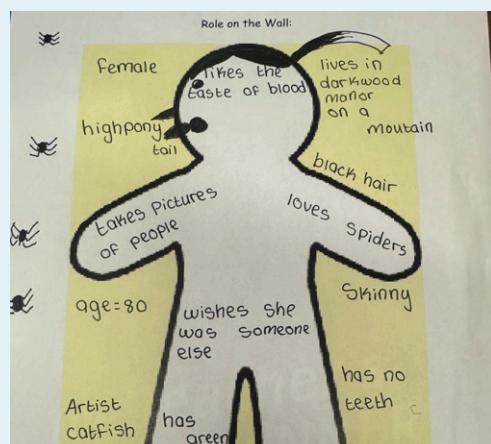


PE Workshop

On Monday 13th January the Year 10 Sport and Coaching Principles exam class participated in a team building workshop. The workshop was led by Georgia from the LSSP, and focused on developing both practical coaching skills and the ability to manage risks effectively in sport. During the session, pupils took part in a variety of tasks and activities that required them to use their coaching skills, including adapting tasks, communicating with participants, offering feedback and empowering their teammates.

Pupils worked collaboratively, applying their understanding of coaching techniques in a hands on environment. In addition to coaching practice, pupils also engaged in a discussion about the importance of minimising risk during physical activity; exploring strategies for ensuring participant safety through effective warm-ups, correct use of equipment and the importance of assessing the environment prior to beginning an activity.

The workshop helped students not only refine their coaching abilities but also understand the responsibility they hold in maintaining a safe and supportive environment for participants through fun and engaging tasks.
