## Well done, keep going!

All pupils who are currently taking part in either their Bronze (Year 9) or Silver (Year 10) Award should be busy each week working towards completing their Skills, Physical and Volunteering sections.

To achieve their Award, pupils must complete these three parts of the Duke of Edinburgh Award. Only if they are showing steady progress towards finishing these, then they will be invited to attend the later expeditions.

As D of E Manager, I see the regular progress made by so many of our pupils. Once a particular section is complete (after 3 or 6 months), participants are required to upload a completed assessor report to their online accounts. Many pupils also upload additional evidence, such as photographs, to show their regular attendance and progress.

Current Year 9 pupils have chosen a huge range of extra curricular skills to improve. These include cooking, playing a musical instrument and learning first aid. Physical activities have included attending the gym weekly, taking part in Park Run and Dance.



It is encouraging to see so many of the pupils take part in a wide variety of volunteering activities. Well done Hava O. for supporting the Greenhouse Project. Keep up the great work Ava C. you are doing with the Kensington Fields Community Centre. It's great to see Faith N. help keep Norris Green Park clean by doing regular litter picking.

**Congratulations** to Linea F, Anitte S J, Abi C, Scarlett A and Agnes B in Year 11 who have now fully completed all four parts of their Silver Award they started last year. Their certificates and badges are now ready to collect.

Any pupils who have started their Award in a previous (Bronze or Silver) year but have yet to complete all four sections should initially log in and check their e-dofe account and school e-mails and see Mr Halewood if they are unsure of what they need to do next.

## Expedition section (reminder)

Along with the Physical, Skills and Volunteering sections, the Expedition section forms a vital part of the Duke of Edinburgh Award. The aim of this section is to inspire young people to develop initiative and a spirit of adventure and discovery by planning, training for and completing an adventurous self-sufficient journey as part of a team. At Bronze, the expedition involves two days of walking and navigating, with an overnight camp. Silver has two expeditions, each over three days.

Pupils must be self sufficient during their expedition (carrying their tents, food, stoves etc in their rucksacks). There must be between four and seven participants in a team and in the past, successful groups may not have always had the best navigation skills but worked well together to overcome any challenges. Each group must have a team goal – what they want to achieve.

## Silver Award

Practice Expedition (West Lancashire) Thursday 19th June – Saturday 21st June  
Qualifying Expedition (Ribble Valley) Thursday 3rd July – Saturday 5th July.

## Bronze Award

Training Day Friday 16th May  
Day Walk Expedition training (Aintree loop) Saturday 24th May  
Qualifying Expedition (Ribble Valley) Friday 6th – Saturday 7th June.

An extensive kit list can be found on the D of E website ([https://www.dofe.org/wp-content/uploads/2024/10/DofE\\_ExpeditionKitList\\_October\\_2024.pdf](https://www.dofe.org/wp-content/uploads/2024/10/DofE_ExpeditionKitList_October_2024.pdf)) and more advice about essential kit will be given out on the training events. School will loan (deposit required) the potentially more expensive items; tents, rucksacks and Trangia stoves to groups.
