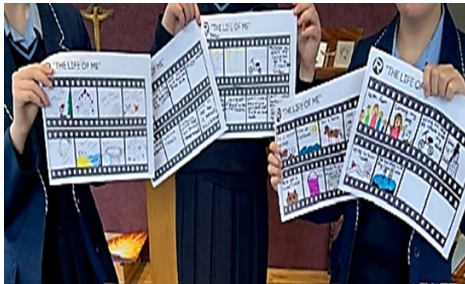
Weekly Prayer

Bring your own snacks as we watch a prequel to Dickens' classic novel, Oliver Twist to celebrate National Storytelling Week and the joy of stories.

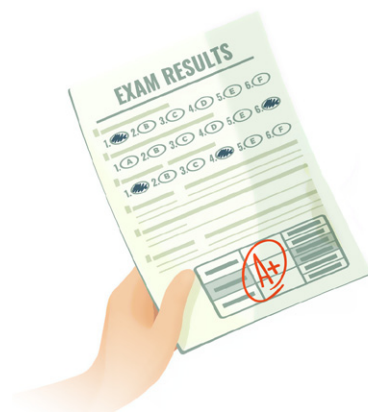

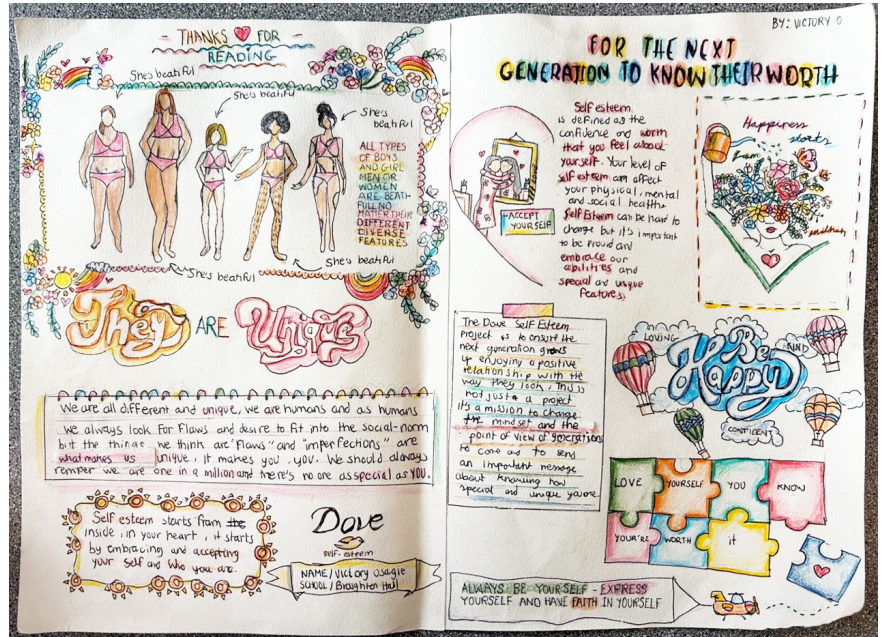
