On Friday 8th March, our year 11 Geographers went out to Liverpool One to carry out a fieldwork study in preparation for their GCSE exams. They were investigating the key question: "to what extent has the Liverpool One Regeneration Scheme been effective?" Students gathered primary research data in the form of pedestrian counts, land-use surveys, environmental quality surveys and questionnaires.

Students really benefitted from getting out and practicing these geographical skills, whilst applying it to their local environment. Their next stop is further afield when they will be going to carry out more fieldwork techniques – but this time in a river!





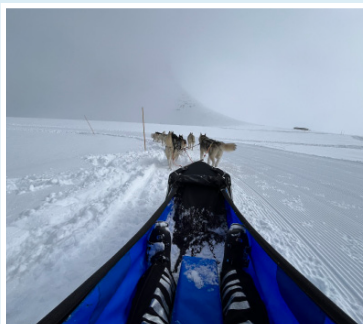
Food: Mini Meringues
