Emmanuel whose name is Love.*

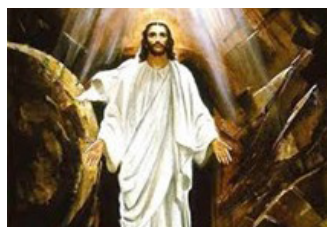

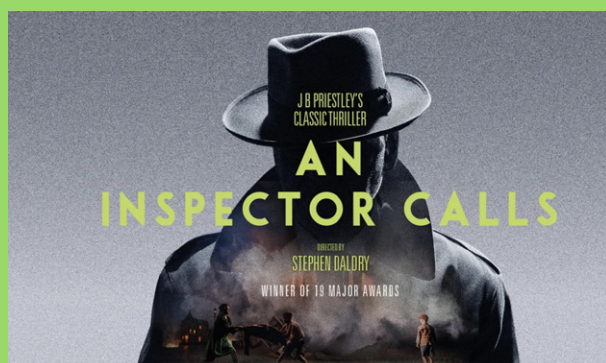
