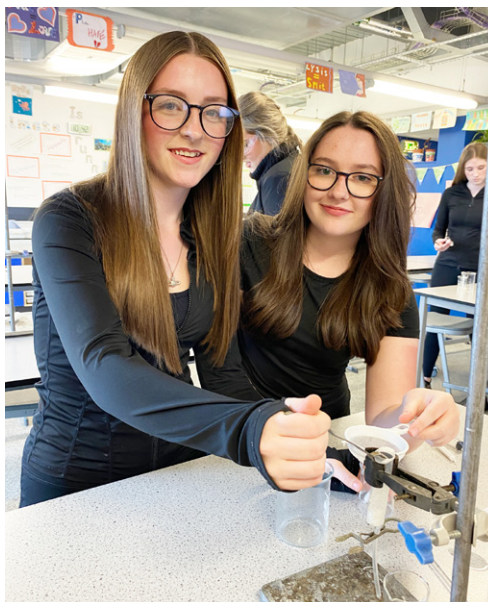

This achievement reflects not only their hard work and dedication. Our athletes competed fiercely in a range of events, from sprints and distance runs to field events like long jump, high jump, and shot put.



We are proud to announce the following standout performances:

- Year 7: Our youngest competitors made a strong impression at their first senior school event, coming third in their relay heat.
- Year 8: This year group demonstrated remarkable prowess, with Vera N taking home bronze in the shot put and the discus; ranking third in Liverpool. Isabel A and Mollie H earned a well-deserved finals spot in the 100m and 200m amongst a very talented field, as well as a bronze medal in the long jump.
- Year 9: Our Year 9 athletes delivered outstanding results, with multiple pupils across events securing finals positions.
- Year 10: A spectacular display of skill and endurance was shown by our older students. Jenna C achieved gold in the 300m, and silver in the 200m and triple jump; Favour N-O achieved bronze in the javelin; Lucy M a bronze in the long jump.

The Athletics City Championships have been a triumph for our school, showcasing the incredible talent and resilience of our students. We are immensely proud of their accomplishments and look forward to supporting them in future competitions.

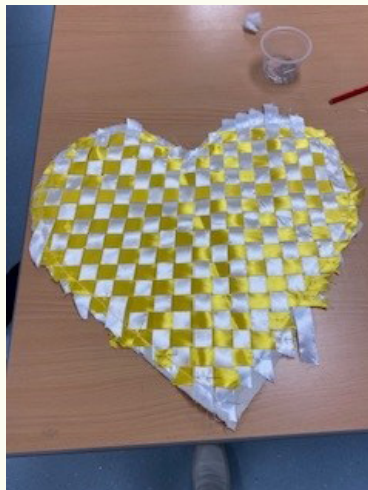


Fundraising
